Essential Job Functions

- 3. All other duties as assigned by the President as needed.

Requirements

- 1. Possess a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering or related field.
- 2. Possess experience in concrete pipe/precast industry, construction, engineering, or related field preferred.
- 3. Registered Professional Engineer preferred.



- 4. If licensed, must maintain Professional Engineers' License and any professional development hours in accordance with local state board minimum requirements for licensure.
- 5. Expected to travel up to approximately 30 weeks/annually (70% of possible work weeks) with overnight travel.

Other Skills/Abilities

Relationship Building Skills

This position requires strong interpersonal and relationship building skills. The RE must work closely with producing members and important industry colleagues and be relied upon as an industry expert.

Collaborative Skills

This position requires the ability to work collaboratively with other RE's, employees, and members to plan and implement strategies to meet ACPA strategic goals.

Self-Management Skills

This position requires a high degree of self-motivation and the ability to work independently for long periods of time. Employee must be able to self-prioritize their workload, ensuring that internal and external customers' needs are met, and activities are focused on advancing the mission of the ACPA.

Language and Communication Skills

- 1. Ability to read, write and comprehend instructions, correspondence, memos, and contracts.
- 2. Ability to comfortably and effectively present information in one-on-one, small and large group situations to members, professionals, and other employees of the organization.
- 3. Ability to timely respond to customers, both internally and externally utilizing diplomatic skills to accomplish goals.

Environmental Requirements

- 1. Will be required to work at home, on the road, and at customers' and ACPA offices.
- 2. Frequent overnight travel required.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to operate computer keyboard and telephone, reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand, walk, and sit. The employee is occasionally required to climb or balance and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must be able to drive and/or fly for long stretches of time. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, infrequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
